

PROFILE VICE-CHAIR NEAR SURFACE GEOSCIENCE DIVISION

Responsibilities Vice- Chair NSGD

- The Vice-Chair shall perform the duties of the Chair in the latter's absence.

Responsibilities

- Attend the Board meetings, who meet five times per year: the Friday meeting of the annual conference in June (start of President's tenure), September, December, March and the Sunday meeting of the annual conference in June. An additional meeting may be held when actual developments require so.
- As board member provide governance and strategic vision for the Association.
- Manage the division and represent the division members' views at Board level.
- Chair of the Near Surface Geoscience Committee. The committee represents and promotes the interests of its division and ensures that each of the geoscientific and related engineering disciplines is adequately represented within EAGE and its committees.
- Organise divisional committee meetings throughout the year.

Commitment

- Travelling to Board meetings: a Board meeting is normally spread over two days (one full and one half day). The meetings are predominantly held at the office in Houten (the Netherlands), but can also be organised at the location of an EAGE event.
- Representing the association at the annual conference & exhibition (6 days, June).
- Representing the association at the annual European Meeting of Environmental and Engineering Geophysics (5 days, September).

Requirements

- EAGE member in good standing.
- Demonstrated active membership.
- Excellent intercultural communication skills.
- Permission to travel.
- Experience on a board of a professional or volunteer organisation is welcome but not required.
