DESIDERIUS ERASMUS AWARD

For lifetime contribution in the field of resource exploration and development.



HONORARY MEMBERSHIPS

For an outstanding contribution to the scientific and technical advancement of the geosciences, particularly geophysics.



ALFRED WEGENER AWARD

For an outstanding contribution to the scientific and technical advancement of EAGE's disciplines, particularly petroleum geoscience and engineering.



ARIE VAN WEELDEN AWARD

For a Young Professional who has made a highly significant contribution to one or more of the disciplines in our Association.

HOW TO NOMINATE

Nominate a fellow geoscientist or engineer for an award by submitting a nomination package via the EAGE website before 31 October. A complete nomination package consists of:

- a citation letter explaining why the nominee deserves the award;
- the nominee's curriculum vitae and list of publications (if applicable), and
- at least one letter of reference from an independent person able to support the nomination.
